

Magis TV on PC Guide

Complete Installation & Setup via BlueStacks Emulator

Introduction

Magis TV is a popular streaming application primarily designed for Android devices (Smart TVs and TV Boxes). To run it on a Windows or Mac computer, you need an Android emulator. **BlueStacks** is the industry-leading choice for stability and performance.

Prerequisites

- **PC OS:** Windows 7 or higher / macOS.
- **Processor:** Intel or AMD Multi-Core (Virtualization must be enabled in BIOS).
- **RAM:** At least 4GB (8GB recommended).
- **Storage:** 5GB free disk space.

Note: Since Magis TV is a third-party application, ensure you download the APK from a trusted source to avoid malware.

Step 1: Install BlueStacks

- 1 Visit the official [BlueStacks website](#) and download the latest version (BlueStacks 5 is recommended).
- 2 Run the installer and click "**Install Now**".

3 Once installed, launch BlueStacks and sign in with your Google Account to access the engine features.

Step 2: Obtain the Magis TV APK

Because Magis TV is not typically available on the Google Play Store, you must "sideload" the APK file:

1. Open the browser (Chrome/Edge) on your **PC** (not inside the emulator yet).
2. Search for the official Magis TV website or a reputable APK mirror.
3. Download the latest **Magis TV APK** file to your desktop.

Step 3: Install Magis TV on BlueStacks

There are two easy ways to install the APK into the emulator:

Method A: Drag and Drop

Simply drag the downloaded **.apk** file from your computer folder and drop it onto the BlueStacks home screen. It will install automatically.

Method B: Sidebar Tool

Click the **"Install APK"** button (the APK icon) on the right-hand sidebar of BlueStacks. Locate your file and click "Open".

Step 4: Configuration & Performance

For the best streaming experience without lag:

- Go to **Settings** (gear icon) in BlueStacks.
- **Performance:** Set CPU Allocation to "High (4 Cores)" and Memory Allocation to "High (4 GB)".
- **Graphics:** Ensure "Graphics Engine Mode" is set to "Compatibility" and "Graphics Renderer" to "OpenGL".

Pro Tip: Enable **Fullscreen Mode** (F11) while watching content for a true TV-like experience on your monitor.

Troubleshooting

- **App Crashing:** Try clearing the app cache within the BlueStacks Android settings.
- **Black Screen:** Update your PC's Graphics Card drivers (NVIDIA/AMD/Intel).
- **Connection Error:** Check your PC's firewall settings to ensure BlueStacks has internet access.
